





Talk about plants: "Plants have life": They also grow like us. If you cut a tree or break a plant from its roots, it will not grow.



<u>Activity</u>: Growing a Plant – Help the child to sow a seed in a small pot, water it everyday and watch it grow. Mention the dates on which:


